## 1) Symposium on State of Exception and Private Law.

- Approximate date: June 2023
- Request for invitation from you of possible further colleagues and speakers.
- Number of sessions: in principle 7 or 8. Namely the following:
  - 1) General theory and methodology.
  - 2) Law of persons.
  - 3) Family law and succession.
  - 4) Obligations and contracts
  - 5) Liability.
  - 6) Property
  - 7) Commercial law
  - 8) Civil procedural law.

As a general, common rule, we will ask each speaker to send us in good time a very short abstract of his or her paper as well as the area within which he or she intends to deliver it.

**The methodological framework.** In recent times, as is well known, the subject has been dealt with extensively due to the pandemic.

An outline of the Symposium analysis will be sent to all interested speakers shortly, mainly extending the area of investigation to all plausible State of Exception hypotheses, not limiting its scope to the pandemic event.

Each speaker will of course be free to adhere or not to this methodological hypothesis.

Following the Symposium, written proceedings will be requested from the speakers, and these will be published in the Institute's journal, *International Notebooks of Private Law*.

Speakers with expertise from other disciplines are as you know more than welcome to our works, such as Roman law, philosophy of law, commercial law.

- 9) The holder's situations in front of circulation of quota and right of withdrawal.
- 10) Modern doctrines of LLCs.
